

Fire Island

Vocabulary Guide

Full-Share: Renting an entire summer in a share house that can be a bed, bedroom or entire house

Half-Share: Renting a bed or room in a share every other weekend for approximately 10 weekends in the summer

Grove, The: Neighboring town to the Pines with its own Ferry service, stores, restaurants and dance hall called the Ice Palace

Meat Rack: The sand dunes between the two towns of The Pines and Cherry Grove where many men go to have sex

<u>Pantry:</u> The local market and general store of Fire Island Pines located in Town

<u>Pavillion:</u> The name of the disco/dance hall in Fire Island Pines

Planter's Punch: Two ounces of rum, a quarter of an ounce of grenadine, sour mix, orange juice, and a red cherry.
Or, if you love pineapple, you can substitute

Quarter-Share: Renting a bed or room in a summer share once a month for approximately 5 times in the summer

Share: A summer resort house or a room itself in which different people rent weekend packages sharing a common area and utilities

Tea: Happy Hour usually consisting of gay men that takes place in the late afternoon or early evening on weekends

Town: Central village area of Fire Island Pines where the ferry arrives in the harbor with stores, pantry and dance hall

Robert worked as an Administrative Law Judge for New York City and currently sits as a Broward County, Florida THO Magistrate. He was appointed a Law Review Editor at Tour Law School. Robert also produced 'Cyber Seder', the first religious Internet Broadcast that was also curated in the Paley Center for Media, Museum of Television & Radio. He was also 3-Time President of the NYPD 1st Precinct Police Council & a Big Apple Greeter.
